- Coupons will be automatic
- One employee resigned; had been on leave; friendly terms by their choice
- Talking with Joe Barnes about staff morale and culture
- Continue family meals, hazard pay, and partial unemployment
- Moving to expand hours if possible
- Customers adapting well to door service model
- Haven't hit a ceiling yet for ability to fill online orders, good thing!
- Now we can parse out quantity of online orders done each day
- Automatic price lowering happening for member special orders
- Working on margin strategy
- Bringing in new products that we never could before because of price
- Working on being a leader in the grocery community with how to function in this new reality
- Earth Fare is carrying Field Day and not any private label, our pricing will be better on those products
- Still working on PPP forgiveness application
- Liquidity is still in good shape
